

Regulation concerning amendments to Regulations on security, anti-terrorism and anti-piracy measures and the use of force on board ships and mobile offshore drilling units (Security Regulations)

Legal basis: Laid down by the Norwegian Maritime Authority on 17 February 2017 under the Act of 16 February 2007 No. 9 relating to ship safety and security (Ship Safety and Security Act), sections 2, 6, 39, 40, 43 and 47, cf. Formal Delegation of 16 February 2007 No. 171 and Formal Delegation of 31 May 2007 No. 590.

I

Regulations of 22 June 2004 No. 972 on security, anti-terrorism and anti-piracy measures and the use of force on board ships and mobile offshore drilling units (Security Regulations) are amended as follows:

Section 6 second paragraph first sentence should read:

Annex XIII point 56r of the EEA Agreement (Regulation (EC) No 324/2008 of 9 April 2008 laying down revised procedures for conducting Commission inspections in the field of maritime security, as amended by Implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/462) shall apply as regulation with amendments and additions pursuant to Annex XIII, Protocol 1 to the Agreement and the Agreement in general.
